



KEYBOARDING ELECTIVE

Keyboarding is an elective that is required before a student may sign up for the elective GEN Y class. This keyboarding class is an introduction to learning the keys of the keyboard and the correct fingering techniques needed to type with speed and accuracy. This class consists of a series of drills, quizzes, and 15 Speed and Accuracy Tests to help you improve keyboarding techniques and speed. To complete the class all 15 Speed and Accuracy Tests must be completed by the end of the second quarter of the class. **At the end of the second quarter of this class--- All unfinished Tests will count as zeros with a grade of an "F".**

Grades: Grades are based on points given for each of the categories and the percentage given for each category.
